

What to do if your child is exposed to COVID-19:

Is your child fully vaccinated?

YES

No quarantine needed, unless symptoms develop. Test 3-5 days after exposure.

NO

Has your child had a positive COVID-19 test in the last 90 days?

YES

No quarantine needed, unless symptoms develop. Test 3-5 days after exposure.

NO

Quarantine your child for 10-14 days from exposure*
Watch for symptoms.
If possible, have your child quarantine away from others in your home.

*Quarantine for exposed unvaccinated individuals should be at least 10 days from the date of exposure without a test or 7 days since the date of the exposure with a negative test obtained at least 5 days after exposure.

In some settings, quarantine guidelines may change if masks were consistently used. Please follow the specific guidance you receive from the Arkansas Department of Health (ADH) and/or your child's primary care provider regarding quarantine.
