Craft Kits can be assembled at a location of your choice and delivered or mailed to the Volunteer Engagement Office at ACH or ACNW. We will be excited to greet you at the front entrance of the hospital and snap a photo of your delivery!

GUIDELINES: The safety of our patients, families and team is top priority when we accept generous gift donations. Due to COVID-19 it is imperative that ensure all Kit contents follow the guidelines below.

We will happily and graciously accept Kits with contents that are:

- brand new (including books)
- Unopened packaging if possible for any scissors, glue sticks, etc...
- **non-toxic and latex-free (i.e., balloons and rubber bands)**
- odor-free

Unfortunately, we cannot accept Kits if the contents:

- are gently used (books, magazines, toys)
- are edible (pieces contain food)
- contain latex or toxins (check labels carefully)
- have been stored or displayed for any length of time
- promote violence (i.e. guns, swords, light sabers etc.)
- depict a religious theme of any holiday or other event

TIPS:

- Google or Pinterest can be helpful in determining your craft
- Please include all items needed for each kit within the baggy so no other supplies are needed (sticky/glue dots can be helpful, folding crafts vs. cutting crafts)
- For Craft Kits, please include an instruction guide in the Kit
- Don't underestimate a coloring book and crayon Kit!
- Ziploc baggies are preferred to store all contents
