GUIDELINES: The health and safety of our patients, families and staff is top priority when we accept generous gift donations. Due to COVID-19 (Coronavirus) it is imperative that we take extra care and ask that Kit contents follow the guidelines below.



We will happily and graciously accept Kits with contents that are:

- brand new (including books)
- Unopened packaging if possible for any scissors, glue sticks, etc...
- non-toxic and latex-free
- odor-free

Unfortunately, we cannot accept Kits if the contents:

- are gently used (books, magazines, toys)
- are edible (pieces contain food)
- contain latex or toxins (check labels carefully)
- have been stored or displayed for any length of time
- promote violence (i.e. guns, swords, light sabers etc.)
- depict a religious theme of any holiday or other event



TIPS: • Google or Pinterest can be very helpful in determining what craft to collect items for.

- Please include all items needed for each kit within the baggy so no other supplies are needed (sticky/glue dots can be helpful, folding crafts vs. cutting crafts)
 - Don't underestimate the excitement of a coloring book and crayons!
- Ziploc baggies are preferred to store all contents
